Identified risks and safety information

Measures for minimising risk

- Use suitable lifting and transport equipment.
- Ensure that the product is placed on a stable and level surface.

Material and recycling information

Overloading or damage to the material can result in sharp edges that pose a risk of cuts. To minimise this risk, the following precautions should be taken:

*² Appendix: Crush risk

There is a risk of crushing or trapping fingers and hands when using the product, especially when stacking, folding or unfolding the product. This risk increases if the product is operated improperly or hastily. To reduce this risk, the following measures should be



- Never exceed the maximum load limit.
- Check the product regularly for signs of damage or cracks and do not use it if such defects are present.
- Wear suitable protective gloves when handling the damaged product to protect your hands from sharp edges.

- Keep your hands and fingers away from the stacking, folding or collapsing mechanisms while handling the product.
- Carry out all movements slowly and in a controlled manner to prevent the product from closing unintentionally.
- If necessary, use suitable protective gloves to provide additional protection for your hands.
